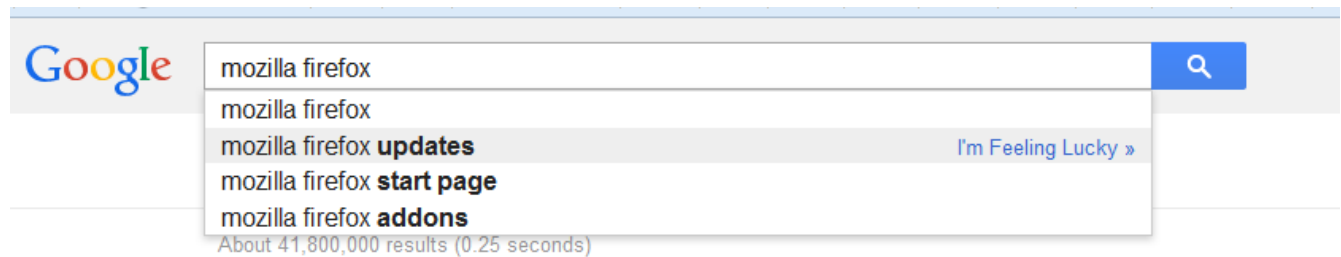

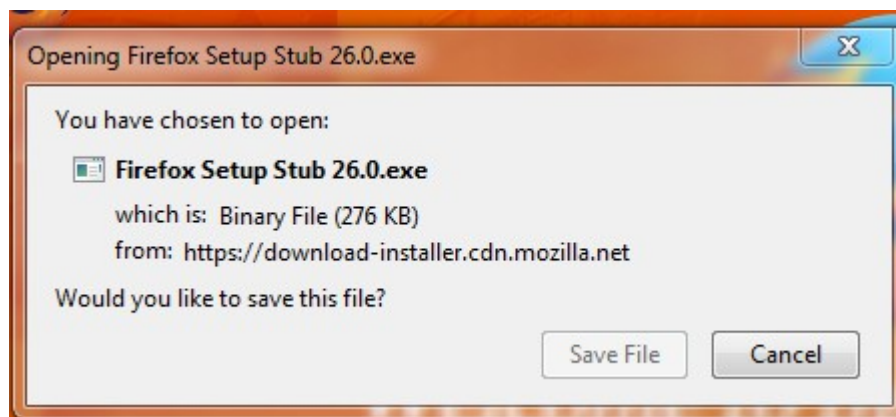

Ensure that you choose the DESKTOP version if loading on a PC, then click on the Free download.

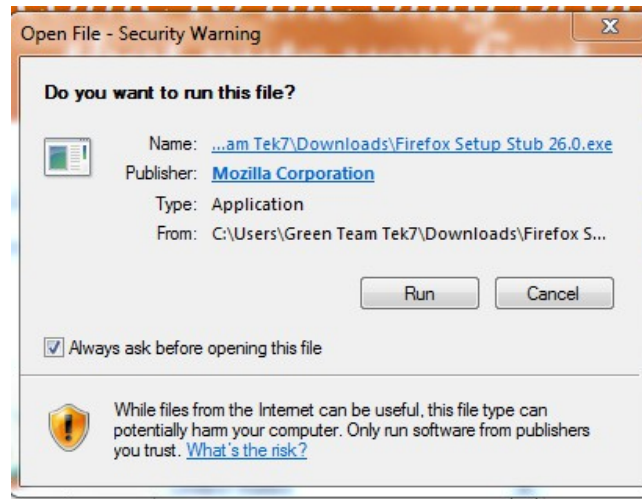

Locate the Firefox set up file in your downloads. Your downloads can be found by clicking on the windows icon and doing a search for downloads. Open the download and then click RUN.



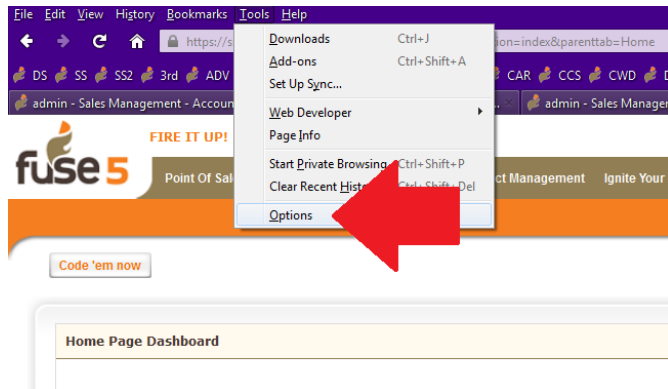
The Mozilla Firefox wizard will open up and guide you through the process of loading it.



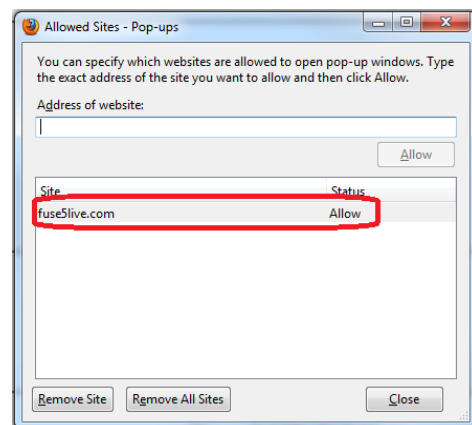
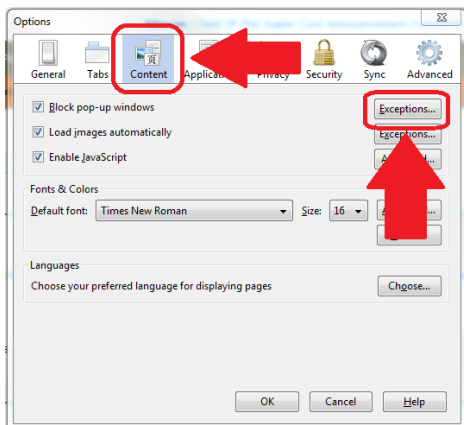

Set up Firefox after you have installed:

Firefox options. 'Tools > Options'

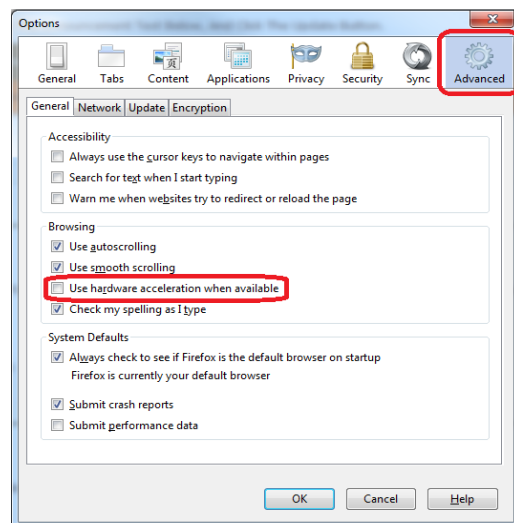


1. Ensure Fuse5 pop-ups are allowed. 'Options > Content > Block pop-up windows > Exceptions'
If "Fuse5live.com" is not in the list of allowed sites then you will have to type it in under 'Address of website' then click the 'Allow' button.

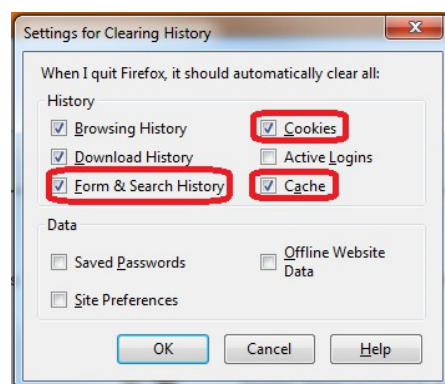
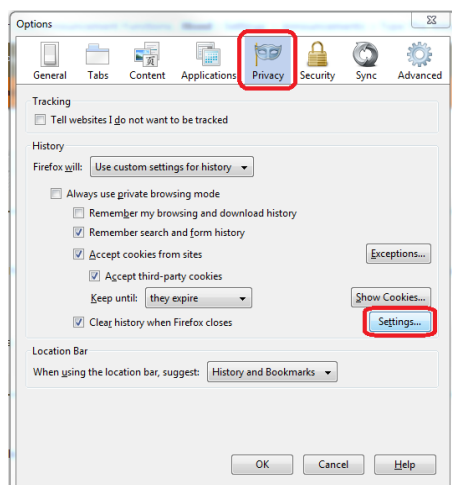

2. Ensure that hardware acceleration is turned off. 'Options > Advanced > Use Hardware...'
If the option 'Use hardware acceleration when available' is turned on then deselect it.

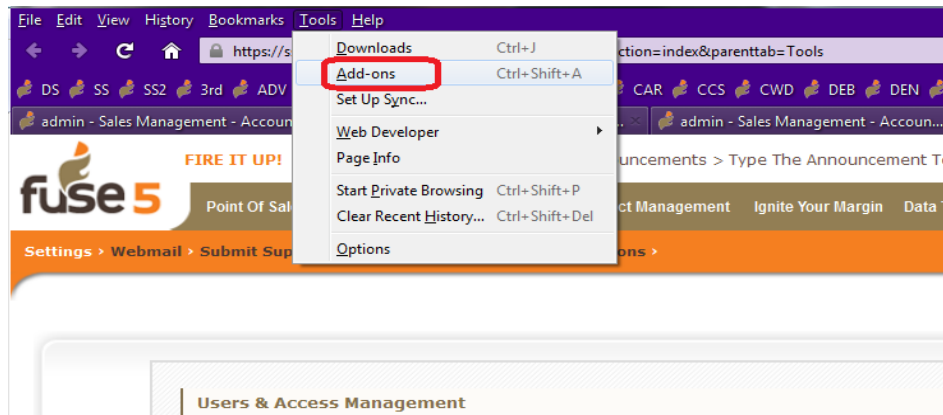


3. Ensure that history is getting cleared. 'Options > Privacy > Settings'
Make sure that Firefox is clearing 'Form & Search History', 'Cookies' and 'Cache' when you quit out of it. Other options like 'Browsing History', 'Download History' & 'Active Logins' should be set based on your organization's policies and procedures.

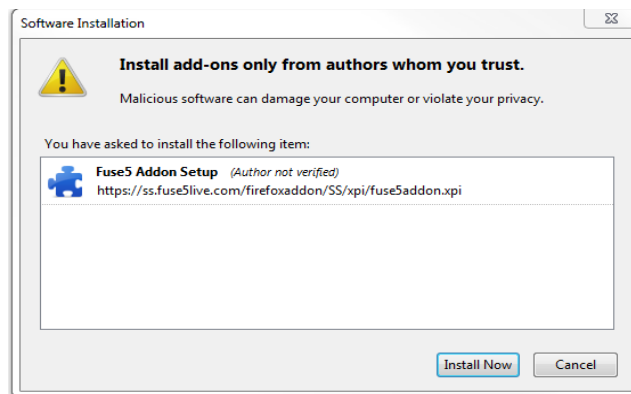


4. Ensure that Fuse5 Addon Setup 2.0 has been installed. 'Tools > Add-ons'
'Fuse5 Addon Setup 2.0' is required for some types of printing done within Fuse5.
Go to the 'Add-ons' interface.

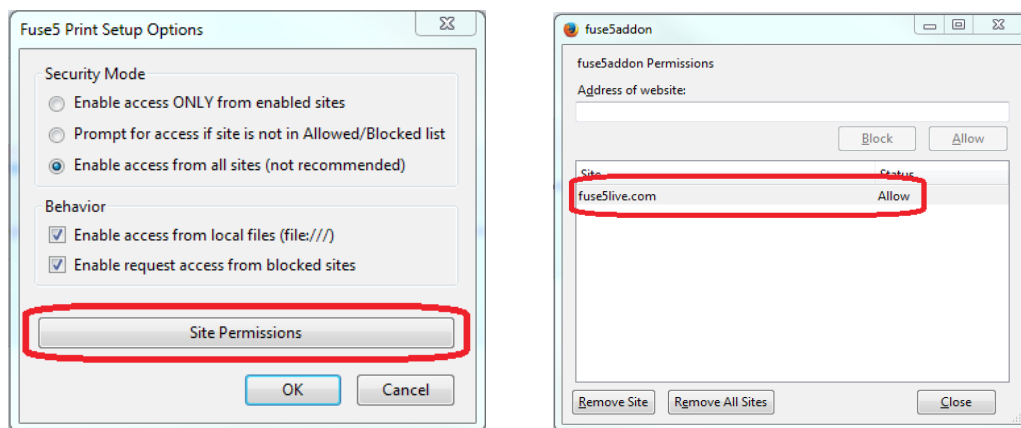

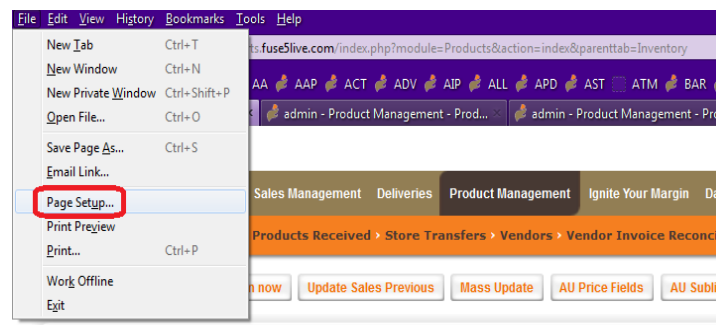
If you do not see Fuse5 Addon Setup 2.0 in the list of 'Extensions' then you will need to add it. Simply click this link [Install Fuse5 Addon](#).



After you have verified that the 'Fuse5 Addon' has been installed ensure that “fuse5live.com” has been allowed access. If not, type in “fuse5live.com” under 'Address of website:' then click the 'Allow' button.



5. Remove any unnecessary header/footer data from Firefox. Go to 'File > Page Setup'.



On the 'Margins & Header/Footer' tab ensure that all of the 'Headers & Footers' drop-downs in the bottom section are set to '--blank--'.
